RE: Proposed implementation of DeliverEASE at The Children's Hospital at Westmead (CHW).

I am writing to the Health Services Union (HSU) to advise of the proposed operational changes within the Sydney Children's Hospitals Network (SCHN) relating to the implementation of the DeliverEASE stock management system at CHW.

CHW is implementing DeliverEASE as part of operationalising the new Wattle building. DeliverEASE is a HealthShare NSW stock management system designed to standardise inventory processes, improve stock availability, and reduce the administrative burden on clinical and support staff.

HealthShare NSW will lead the project in close collaboration with CHW operational, clinical, and stores teams. This includes determining storage and inventory requirements and configuring DeliverEASE to meet CHW's operational needs. Staff will be provided training, change support and transition assistance throughout implementation.

The rollout will commence in the Wattle building as part of its commissioning, followed by a staged expansion in the Banksia building. There is no direct impact on staff positions; however, some staff may experience changes to work practices relating to stock ordering, replenishment and storage processes.
