Dear Mr Hayes

I am writing to advise that we have commenced discussions with the Hastings Macleay Genetics Counsellor, to propose the 0.5 FTE Cancer Genetics portion of the position be realigned to report to the Chief Radiation Therapist. The remaining 0.5 FTE of the role will continue to report to the Service Manager Child, Adolescent and Family Services. This proposed realignment will result in no impact to staffing levels or contracted hours of staff, gradings, or functions.

Mid North Coast Local Health District (MNCLHD) are continuing to review its organisational structure to assure good alignment with service provision, and the proposed changes will result in consistency in reporting lines for all Cancer Genetics Counsellors across MNCLHD.

I have attached the proposed structure for your reference. MNCLHD intends to transition these positions by 8 June 2026 and as such your prompt attention to this matter would be appreciated.
