Mid North Coast Local Health District (MNCLHD) – Cancer Services Team Re-alignment

Dear Mr Hayes

I refer to correspondence of 5 September 2025 from MNCLHD's Chief Executive, Jill Wong, advising of the Ministry of Health's approved Executive Leadership Team (ELT) structure. As a result, some existing functions within MNCLHD are proposed to be re-aligned.

MNCLHD's Mid North Coast Cancer Institute team are currently aligned to the Clinical Services Directorate, with an interim arrangement in the Clinical Services Delivery Directorate. It is our intention to re-align the Mid North Coast Cancer Institute team to the Clinical Acute Services Directorate.

This change will not result in any reduction to overall FTE nor changes to positions within the team. The main change will be the reporting line for the District Manager – Cancer Services, Innovation and Strategy which will remain to an Executive Leadership Team member: from the District Director Clinical Services Delivery to the District Director Clinical Acute Services.

The proposed structure is attached for your reference and consultation has commenced with the Mid North Coast Cancer Institute team. We anticipate that the team will transition to Clinical Acute Services effective **1st June 2026**.
